Standard Licensing Format for All IKS Publications

Q1. What is the licensing format for the publications coming out of IKS Division?

Ans. The goal of IKS Division is to make accessible all information to the widest possible audience with minimum restrictions. All IKS Division publications are open-access and free to download and distribute. The specific licensing format used is **CC BY-SA (Creative Commons Attribution-ShareAlike) license**. This license enables reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format, so long as attribution is given to the creator. The license allows for commercial use. If you remix, adapt, or build upon the material, you must license the modified material under identical terms. (<https://creativecommons.org/share-your-work/cclicenses/>).

Q2. Who retains the copyright?

Ans. Under the **CC BY-SA** license, the **original creator or author retains the copyright** of the work. However, this license allows others to use, share, modify, and build upon the material, provided they give proper credit and distribute any derivative works under the same license.

For **IKS publications**, this means that while the **Author(s) retains copyright**, the content is openly available for public use under the specified terms of **Creative Commons Attribution-ShareAlike (CC BY-SA)**.

Q3. What does the CC BY-SA license allow?

Ans. The CC BY-SA license permits:

- **Sharing** – You can copy and redistribute the material in any format.
- **Adapting** – You can remix, modify, and build upon the material for any purpose, including commercial use.
- **Attribution** – You must give proper credit to the original creator.
- **ShareAlike** – If you make changes or additions, you must license the new content under the same CC BY-SA terms.

Q4. Can IKS publications be used for commercial purposes?

Ans. Yes, the CC BY-SA license allows commercial use **as long as proper attribution is provided** and any modifications or adaptations are shared under the same license.

Q5. Do I need to get permission to use IKS publications?

Ans. No, as long as you follow the terms of the CC BY-SA license, you do not need additional permission. However, **you must give proper credit to the original creator (IKS Division)** and ensure that any adaptations are licensed similarly.

Q6. How should I provide attribution when using IKS publications?

Ans. Proper attribution should include:

1. **Title** of the work
2. **Author/Creator's name** (IKS Division or individual author if specified).
3. **Source/Link** to the original material.
4. **License** (CC BY-SA) along with a link to the license details.

Example Attribution:

“This work, [*Publication Title*] by IKS Division, is licensed under CC BY-SA. Available at: [Link to publication].”
