Poster Guidelines

For presentation purposes, you will be given a space of A0 size (84.1 cm x 118.9 cm). You can use this space creatively for the presentation of your submission idea with relevant results. You may use a single A0 size poster, or multiple A4/A3/A2/A1 posters, or even use the space to put special cut-outs in 2D or 3D. You are encouraged to take this opportunity to ignite your creativity in the presentation to promote IKS in the light of its implementation of NEP2020.

There will be a theme-specific 'Best Presentation Award', and your presentation will be scored in terms of relevance to IKS, novelty of content, value proposition of the idea/result, your creativity in presentation, and some other criteria as may be decided by the organizing committee during the conference.

Specifications for Poster Presentations

- ➔ A0 size (84.1 cm(W) x 118.9 cm(L) or 33.1 inches x 46.8 inches) portrait mode.
- ➔ Be sure to include the main title, names of author co-authors, and the affiliation(s) and the email address of corresponding author.

Instructions for the submission of Abstracts for Poster presentation

- Abstracts can be submitted as pdf file only
- Abstracts can be submitted either in English or Hindi.
- The title of the abstract should be in CAPITAL LETTERS/UPPER CASE. After the title, the author's names, position (UG/PG/PhD) and affiliations need to be mentioned along with their email id for correspondence.
- The abstract (maximum 250 words) should have the following points:
 - a. Keywords (up to six)
 - b. Overview and objective of the poster
 - c. The main results of the poster
 - d. Relevance in the present context
- Up to two figures are allowed in the abstract document.
- We suggest the authors do spell check and correct the grammatical errors before submitting the abstract.
- The abstract's file name should have the theme's name (T1, T2, T3 and so on), followed by the author's first name and affiliation (name of the Institute).
Example: "T1_Rama_Pune_University.pdf"
- Check your pdf file before submitting the form.

Tips for Poster Preparation

- ➡ Posters should stimulate discussion. Therefore, keep text to a minimum, emphasize graphics, and make sure every item included in your poster is necessary.
- ➡ You may utilize handouts to supplement your poster.
- ➡ Make sure ideas flow logically from one section to the next.
- ➡ Use charts and graphs to illustrate data (avoid large tables of raw data).
- ➡ Use high resolution photographs (web images often will not work).
- ➡ The use of handwritten as a poster is unacceptable.
- ➡ Keep consistent margins and line spacing.
- ➡ Test readability.
